Family Outreach-

Need approval and checks/balances for HIPPA compliance for ROI.

Next step, becoming part of the Partnership. Discussing with State partner, Wendy Stut

Wants a script about what is involved in releasing information to the Partnership

IFSP meeting may not be the best option for care coordination, but open to finding a smart

CAPPA Law related coordination is the piece that we are working on perfecting.

Youth Case manager available if child has mental health diagnosis. If under 6, don't have to have a serious emotional disturbance diagnosis to receive services.

Erin will create work flow chart for Voluntary vs. Mandatory SafeCare
